Regarding question no. 2, hopefully the bullets below help to show which grade changes were borderline changes.

They show the proportion of downward adjustments from one grade to another, that came from the lowest Refined Band in the higher grade.

- **Of entries adjusted from a Grade A to B, 52% % were originally estimated to be in Refined Band 5**
- **Of entries adjusted from a Grade B to C, 41% % were originally estimated to be in Refined Band 9**
- **Of entries adjusted from a Grade C to D, 45% were originally estimated to be in Refined Band 13**
- **Of entries adjusted from a Grade D to N, 39% were originally estimated to be in Refined Band 16**
